**Eastern Empire** (em'pīr), *n.* that part of the later Roman Empire

**Eblis** (eb'lis or e'llis), *n.* the Mohammedan Devil; in Mohammedan mythology the chief evil spirit, or any of the former angels who were cast out of Heaven for refusing to worship Adam. [Arabic.]  
**ebonite** (eb'un-īt), *n.* a hard dark variety of vulcanite.  
**ebonize** (eb'un-īz), *v.t.* to make black
